6. Stand Rent

Please find the concrete amount of your stand rent in the booking form. The stand rent only refers to the exhibition space; incidentals and infrastructure services will be charged separately.

7. Admission

(1) The organizer confirms the admission of the applicant and the declared articles by a written approval. Hereby a legally binding contract is concluded between the exhibitor and the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH. All reservations and conditions made by the applicant have to be confirmed in written form by the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH to be effective. The Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH is allowed to refuse applicants because of factual reasons and especially belated applications after November 20, 2019. Besides the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH is allowed to restrict and restructure the booked spaces.

(2) The exhibitor/applicant is obliged to provide all required information to the vokativ GmbH (organizer of the exhibition/event) about his company, the products he wants to exhibit and/or showcase and his services. The vokativ GmbH for its part is obliged to maintain silence about all information obtained as far as it does not affect the security of the event's participants. If the exhibitor's declarations and descriptions are proved false the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH will be authorized to suspend the exhibitor's participation in the short term.

(3) In case of bankruptcy and composition proceedings or his insolvency during contractual relationship the exhibitor is obliged to inform the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH immediately.

8. Withdrawal from the Application/ Cancellation of the Admission

After the application has been confirmed the exhibitor will have to pay the full stand rent if he withdraws from the contract or does not take part in the exhibition. The withdrawal from other booked activities (industry lunch meeting, advertising etc.) by the applicant also results in full payment. The Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH reserves the right to claim damages.

The Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH will be authorized to cancel the admission and allocate the booked spaces anew

- i) if the booked space is not visibly taken in time
- ii) if the stand rent has not been paid in time and a second deadline given by the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH has lapsed without payment.

9. Conditions of Payment

All amounts charged by the organizer have to be paid without discount by the deadlines mentioned in the invoice. 30% of the stand rent has to be paid to the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH in a first rate by January 13, 2020. The rest of the stand rent has to be paid to the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH by February 20, 2020. All payments have to be made exempt from charges. For each payment you will get a confirmation from the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH.

If the payments are not exempt from charges credited to the account of the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH by the day of the exhibition's opening the organizer will be authorized to close down the booth until the payments are made. Claims for reduction in price for the suspended time are not possible.

10. Booth Construction/Booth Arrangement/Safety Regulation

All booths have to be integral and open top. Mountings on the walls, columns, floor and ceiling are forbidden. Booth constructions higher than 3.5 meters have to be approved by the LEIPZIGER MESSE GmbH and the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH. There is an extra fee for booths higher than 4.5 meters because of the additional ad space. Please find the concrete amount on the conference's website. Columns inside are included in the size of the booth. Back and/or side walls, which are visible to visitors, have to be covered in white.

The exhibitor is responsible for damages caused by noncompliance. The Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH reserves the rights to order modifications of deficient booth constructions or the removal of inadequate exhibits that prove disturbing or dangerous for the visitors or neighboring exhibitors. Fire alarm boxes, hydrants, distribution boards, switch panels and telephone distribution must be accessible at all times. The use of naked lights and fires is forbidden. All materials used for the booth construction and decoration have to be proven hardly inflammable. During the setup and dismantling as well as the event the exhibitor shall comply with any applicable administrative regulations. Instructions made by the staff of the Leipziger Messe GmbH and the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH and its agents respectively have to be followed. In any other cases the terms and conditions of the Leipziger Messe GmbH are binding.

Due to legal and insurance reasons it is not allowed to bring any radioactive material into the venue.

11. Exhibitor Badges

The company staff working on the booth gets non-transferable exhibitor badges. The badge entitles the owner to participate in the industry exhibition and the scientific lectures. Each company gets one badge per 2 square meters of booked space. A list with the names of staff has to be sent in via the online-tool by March 15, 2020.

12. Accountability

The exhibitor is accountable for all damages caused by his exhibits or staff members. The exhibitor shall arrange adequate insurance. The exhibitor is responsible for all his materials and exhibits including damages to them caused by the public (especially visitors, other exhibitors, their agents etc.) as well as staff members and agents of the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH and other circumstances. The Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH is only accountable for damages caused deliberately or through gross negligence by its staff members or agents.

13. Changes

As far as it is mandatory for factual reasons the Nuklearmedizin Interaktion GmbH is allowed to cancel the exhibition, to change time and venue if necessary, to modify the duration and stand spaces if necessary due to the spatial situation and any other applicable administrative regulations.

If the modifications are substantial the exhibitor will reserve the right to withdraw from the contract. Any replacement claims will not be affected in case of changes.

14. Place of Performance and Jurisdiction

Place of performance and jurisdiction is for both sides Goettingen/Germany.
